

APPENDIX I-05 (June 2003/May 2005)

SPONSORSHIP for RTA CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION.

- a. The Club shall **Sponsor** Club Members annually to allow Members access and licence to Conditionally Register their eligible vehicle(s) under the RTA Historic Conditional Registration Scheme and NSW Historic number plates as introduced in May 2002.
- b. The NSW Historic 'Conditional' number Plates must be displayed in prominent positions, one on the front and the other on the rear of the vehicle as is required by the Motor Transport regulations.
- c. Use of Name Bars is optional for members that have 'Hillman Club' name bars, until a ruling is determined.
- d. Any member requiring the issue of Sponsorship shall:
- (i) Be a financial Club member for a minimum of *three* months.
 - (ii) Provide Certificate of Currency covering Comprehensive or Third Party Property insurance policy detail of Licenced vehicle, else evidence of Policy Number and date of expiration with the current NSW Historic plate number to the Club Registrar.
 - (iii) Have the vehicle inspected by the Club Registrar, on nominated Registration Inspection Days.
 - (iiiA) Acquire a Pink Slip for self registration with RTA compliance and on Insurance details for Direct payment of Conditional registration renewal.
- e. The vehicle, NSW Historic Conditional Registered plated vehicles, shall be used for authorised Club events, *secondary Club invitation (sanctioned) runs*, traveling to and from such events and for the necessary servicing of the licenced vehicle, but may not be used on other occasions. *Note: Sanctioned means having it logged by the Club Registrar in his events book.*
- (i) exception to (e) can be given by the Registrar, in extreme cases, with the Registrar advising a Member of the Committee, also noting that exception in the "Journey" book/log,
- (ii) A current Hillmanews 'Newsletter' list of approved events must be carried in the Conditional Registered vehicle at all times.
- (iii) Nominated Secondary or ? Club runs with an official invitation to this Club can be sanctioned as long as that Club's event listing/*invitation* is carried in the Historic Conditional Registered vehicle each time.
- (iv) 'P' platers and 'L' learners subject to Membership Rules and RTA regulations are permitted to drive Historic Conditional Registered vehicles on authorised events as defined within.
- (v) All RTA documents pertaining to the Conditional Registration scheme must also be carried in the licenced vehicle.
- f. The Sponsorship for NSW Historic Conditional Registration may be terminated *or refused* by the Club (*Club Registrar*) at any time. Members' Right of Appeal (*explanation of refusal*) will be recognised. In the event of such notification *or* such cancellation, the member shall return the Historic Conditional registration Plates to the RTA Office within seven (7) days from the date of such notification.
- g. Continuation of the Sponsorship of RTA Conditional Registration will be dependent on:
- (i) Remaining a financial member of the Hillman Owners Club of Australia Inc.
 - (ii) The annual renewal of the RTA Historic Conditional Registration for NSW Historic number plate permit to operate the subject vehicle.
 - (iii) Attendance by the licenced vehicle (s) of a minimum of *any three Primary and or sanctioned Secondary* events or meetings in each registration year.
- h. Upon disposal of the vehicle to which a set of NSW Historic conditional registration plates are attached, the member shall forthwith advise the Club Registrar of the sale, and surrender those plates to an RTA office.
- An up-to-date register of the RTA Conditional NSW Historic Plates shall be kept by the Club Registrar and must be produced on demand at any time to the appropriate representative of the Commissioner of Motor Transport.
